AREF PROJECT COMMITTEE

CALL FOR PROJECTS OF A CIVIC OR HUMANITARIAN NATURE

Good news: the situation regarding the COVID-19 pandemic having improved, AREF will once again proceed with the allocation of grants for projects of a civic or humanitarian nature sponsored by its members. We should remember that these projects are most often aimed at groups of young people or seniors, which made it difficult to carry them out during a period of high risk of propagation of the virus.

The objective of this grant program is to allow AREF to contribute to the achievement of individual or collective projects of a social, cultural or intellectual nature, as submitted by members of various regions. You are invited, as a member sponsor of such a project, to submit a grant application by December 31, 2021 for a project to be carried out during the year 2022. The grant policy, selection criteria and application form are available on the AREF website (aref-neq.ca/grant-policy/). The Spring 2021 edition of the [AREF-Info](#) also includes an overview of the Fall 2019 projects that received grants.

The budget for this year will be determined at the AREF Annual General Assembly in early October, but it is expected to be in the same range as in previous years, approximately \$20,000, 25% of which will go to international projects.

Selection criteria also remain the same as in previous years. However, the committee will give special consideration to projects that are contingent on AREF funding and to projects that are not a repetition of or similar to a project already funded by AREF.

We look forward to your proposals.
