2nd CALL FOR PROJECTS FOR 2024

Dear AREF members,

AREF will once again be awarding grants for humanitarian and civic projects to be carried out in 2024. Following the awarding of grants for projects submitted before December 31¹, an amount of \$12,216 remains available, including a maximum amount of \$1,500 for international projects and \$1,500 for lump-sum grants.

Between now and May 15, we invite you to submit a grant application for a local, regional, national, or international project to be carried out in 2024, or a request for a lump-sum grant. Remember that you must be a member of AREF and a volunteer sponsor of the submitted project.
