**REMINDER – 1**<sup>st</sup> **CALL FOR PROJECTS TO BE CARRIED OUT IN 2026** (June 2 Newsletter)

Dear AREF members,

We would like to remind you that you have until **December 1** to apply for a grant – regular or lump-sum – for a humanitarian or civic project to be carried out **in 2026**.

This program enables AREF to contribute to the realization of individual or collective projects of a social, cultural, or intellectual nature in our community. The annual budget is \$30,000, including a maximum amount of \$7,500 reserved for the international component. The committee wishes to receive grant applications for international projects during the first call for proposals.

As a **volunteer member sponsoring** such a project, you are invited to submit your application for financial support by **December 1, 2025**.
