REMINDER – 2nd CALL FOR PROJECTS TO BE CARRIED OUT IN 2026

(February 2 Newsletter)

Dear AREF members,

We would like to remind you that you have until **May 10** to submit a grant application – either a standard or lump-sum grant – for a humanitarian or civic project. This program allows AREF to contribute to the realization of individual or collective projects of a social, cultural, or intellectual nature in our community.

Following the awarding of grants for applications submitted in the first call for proposals, \$13,200 remains available, including a maximum of \$4,200 for international projects and \$1,500 for lump-sum grants. **To date, we have received only a few projects of these two types.**

By **May 10**, we invite you to submit a grant application for a local, regional, national or international project **to be carried out in 2026**, or a lump-sum grant application. Remember that you must be a member of AREF and a volunteer sponsor of the submitted project.
